



# CONTROLLING UNMANNED AIRCRAFT

Legal, Certification, Security and Operational Challenges

## Overview

This one day training and information session focuses on providing an up-to-date overview of Unmanned Aircraft System (UAS) operations and their potential application across both public and private sectors.
